Chicago's Merchandise Mart to Double as Canvas for Projected Art

A plan to convert the front wall of the building was unveiled during a weekend press conference. Called "Art on the MART," the initiative will launch this fall and will cover the structure's 2.5-acre river-facing facade with images and video.
